
SUBJECT: Anti-Human Trafficking Initiative for Haiti Relief Efforts

The crisis in Haiti has caused thousands of Haitians to migrate in search of food, clothing, shelter and medical services. Natural disasters present dangerous secondary circumstances that may fuel human trafficking or Trafficking in Persons (TIP) activities.

It is DoD's policy to educate and deter activities of military members, civilian employees, indirect hires, contract personnel, and command-sponsored dependents that would facilitate or support TIP, domestically and overseas.
